These Terms and Conditions govern applications for and awards under the Onsego Finish Strong GED Scholarship. If application materials or an award notice conflict with these Terms and Conditions, these Terms and Conditions control to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Quick summary for applicants

- Onsego awards three scholarships each month to selected applicants.
- Each scholarship provides the selected recipient with one year of free access to Onsego Advantage Pro, currently valued at \$199.
- Applicants must live in the United States and be eligible to take the official GED test in the state where they live.
- Applying does not guarantee selection. Scholarships are awarded after application review and verification, not by random drawing.
- The scholarship is personal to the selected recipient. It cannot be sold, transferred, shared, exchanged, or redeemed for cash.
- Applicants must provide complete, truthful, and verifiable information. Fraud, attempted resale, impersonation, duplicate applications, or account sharing may result in rejection or cancellation.

Important: Onsego provides GED preparation. It does not administer the official GED test or issue GED credentials. Scholarship recipients remain responsible for confirming and satisfying the GED eligibility and testing requirements that apply in their state.

1. Sponsor and program administrator

The Onsego Finish Strong GED Scholarship (the "Program") is sponsored and administered by Onsego Prep LLC, doing business as Onsego ("Onsego"), 7901 4th St N, STE 300, St. Petersburg, FL 33702, USA.

Onsego may interpret and apply these rules, correct clerical or administrative errors, request information needed to evaluate or verify an application, and make eligibility and award determinations in its reasonable discretion, subject to applicable law.

2. Scholarship award

Each scholarship provides one selected recipient with one year of access to Onsego Advantage Pro. The regular retail value is currently \$199 and may change without affecting an award already issued.

The scholarship covers access only to the features and services included in Advantage Pro at the time of activation. It does not include cash, equipment, internet service, transportation, official GED test fees, retesting fees, or other third-party costs unless Onsego expressly states otherwise in writing.

A scholarship has no cash value and may not be substituted, sold, transferred, assigned, shared, exchanged, or redeemed for cash or credit.

3. Eligibility

To be considered, an applicant must meet all of the following requirements:

- Currently live in the United States.
- Be eligible to take the official GED test in the state where the applicant lives.
- Not already hold a high school diploma or completed high school equivalency credential.
- Apply personally and on the applicant's own behalf.
- Need assistance paying for GED preparation and be prepared to begin studying promptly.

- Have regular internet access and access to a compatible phone, tablet, or computer.
- Provide complete, truthful, accurate, and verifiable application information.

Applicants who have passed one or more GED subjects but have not completed the full credential may apply. Applicants under age 18 may be required to provide permission from a parent or legal guardian before an award is activated.

Onsego's scholarship eligibility determination is separate from official GED testing eligibility. Each applicant is solely responsible for confirming and meeting the rules that apply in the applicant's state.

4. Monthly application cycle

The application deadline is the last day of each calendar month. Onsego selects three recipients from the eligible applications considered for that monthly cycle.

Applications received after a deadline may be considered during a later cycle. Submission does not guarantee review within a particular cycle, selection, or receipt of a scholarship. Applicants who are not selected may submit a new application in a later month unless Onsego instructs otherwise.

5. Application review and selection

Scholarships are not awarded by random drawing, lottery, or chance. Onsego reviews applications and selects recipients based on Program-related considerations, which may include eligibility, completeness, credibility, readiness to begin, demonstrated commitment, need for assistance, alignment with the Program's purpose, and the ability to verify the application.

Onsego may review publicly available information, including information available through social media profiles provided by an applicant, and may request additional information when reasonably necessary. Onsego does not disclose its complete internal verification or selection procedures.

Incomplete, duplicate, false, misleading, inconsistent, manipulated, or unverifiable applications may be rejected. Onsego may decline to make an award when it cannot reasonably verify an applicant or when selection would create a material safety, fraud, integrity, or reputational concern for the Program. Decisions are final except for the correction of clerical or administrative errors.

The Program will be administered in a nondiscriminatory manner consistent with applicable law.

6. Activation, access, and recipient responsibilities

Selected recipients will be contacted at the email address provided in the application. Additional verification and, when applicable, parent or guardian permission may be required before access is activated.

A selected recipient must activate the scholarship account within the period stated in the award email and should begin studying promptly. Failure to complete required verification or activation may result in forfeiture and selection of another recipient.

Recipients are expected to study consistently, maintain accurate account information, respond to reasonable Program progress check-ins, and inform Onsego when they take or pass GED subject tests. Recipients remain responsible for scheduling, paying for, and completing their official GED tests.

Access is governed by Onsego's website terms, privacy policy, acceptable-use requirements, and applicable course rules. Scholarship access expires one year after activation unless Onsego states otherwise in writing. Unused access has no cash or credit value.

7. Account ownership and prohibited conduct

The scholarship account is personal to the selected recipient. Login credentials and course access may not be sold, advertised for sale, transferred, shared, rented, assigned, or used by another person.

Prohibited conduct includes attempted resale, account sharing, impersonation, false identity information, duplicate or coordinated applications, manipulation of verification information, unauthorized access, misuse of course content, and conduct that violates Onsego's terms or applicable law.

Onsego may suspend, revoke, or cancel a scholarship or account without compensation if it reasonably determines that an applicant or recipient was ineligible, provided false or misleading information, misused the Program, violated these Terms and Conditions, or attempted to sell, transfer, or share the scholarship.

8. Privacy and verification

By applying, an applicant authorizes Onsego to collect, use, store, and review information reasonably necessary to process the application, verify identity and eligibility, prevent fraud, select recipients, administer awards, communicate with applicants, monitor participation, evaluate the Program, and maintain appropriate records.

Applicants may be required to provide links to personal social media profiles they currently use. Onsego may review information that is publicly available through those profiles. Providing a profile link does not give Onsego permission to publish an applicant's posts, photographs, profile information, or personal story.

Applicant information may be processed by service providers that help Onsego operate its website, forms, communications, learning platform, fraud prevention, and recordkeeping, subject to appropriate arrangements and Onsego's Privacy Policy.

9. Stories, testimonials, and publicity

Applicants and recipients may be invited to share a story, testimonial, quote, photograph, video, or progress update. Public participation is optional and is not a condition of eligibility or selection.

Onsego will obtain separate permission before publicly using an applicant's or recipient's name, likeness, story, photograph, video, or other personal content for marketing, publicity, sponsor reporting, or promotional purposes. Aggregated or de-identified Program information may be used to evaluate and describe Program results.

10. No guarantee of GED completion or other outcome

A scholarship provides access to GED preparation but does not guarantee readiness, eligibility to test, a passing score, completion of the GED credential, admission to a school or training program, employment, increased income, or any other result.

Results depend on factors including the recipient's participation, preparation, circumstances, testing eligibility, and completion of official testing requirements.

11. Technical issues and communications

Onsego is not responsible for applications or communications that are lost, late, incomplete, inaccessible, misdirected, filtered as spam, corrupted, or affected by internet, device, email, platform, or other technical problems outside Onsego's reasonable control.

Applicants are responsible for providing a working email address, monitoring their inbox and spam folders, and keeping their contact information current.

12. Program changes or termination

Onsego may modify, suspend, postpone, or terminate the Program, an application cycle, or an award when reasonably necessary because of fraud, abuse, technical failure, legal requirements, operational changes, funding or sponsor changes, circumstances beyond Onsego's reasonable control, or other conditions that materially interfere with Program administration.

When practical, changes will not reduce an already activated recipient's stated one-year access unless the recipient violates these Terms and Conditions or Onsego's generally applicable terms.

13. General terms

The Program is void where prohibited or restricted by law. If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is found unenforceable, the remaining provisions will continue in effect to the fullest extent permitted by law. Failure to enforce a provision is not a waiver of that provision.

These Terms and Conditions, together with the application materials, award email, Onsego Privacy Policy, and applicable website terms, form the rules governing the Program. No oral statement changes these Terms and Conditions.

To the extent permitted by law, these Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of the State of Florida, without regard to conflict-of-law principles. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions limits rights that cannot legally be limited.
